No unleached ashes shall be kept in wooden vessels nearer than 30 feet to the insured buildings, unless in brick or stone ash house. All fire or chimney boards shall be lined at the bottom with iron or other metal.

If a stove or stoves be used, pipes passing through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or otherwise sufficiently secured; and if pipes pass into the upper story, they shall be secured in the same manner. If chimneys are used, they must be properly arranged and the pipe not less than 12 inches in diameter in the clear. No pipe shall pass over the top wall of a roof.

I form the applicant that he will be bound by the application, and, if the risk be more hazardous than appears from his statement, the Company will not be liable in case of Loss.
