No unbleached ashes shall be kept in wooden vessels nearer than 30 feet to the insured premises, unless in brick or stone ash house. All fire or chimney boards shall be lined at the bottom with tin or other metal.

If a stove or stoves be used, pipe passing through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or other equally sufficient secured; and if pipes pass into flue or other story it shall be with an elbow, and the flue shall be built with brick, laid flat; or, when fire clay chimneys are used, they must be securely arranged and the pipe not less than six inches in diameter in the clear. No pipe shall pass through the side wall or roof.
