Dear Sir:-

In looking over my insurance policies recently, I observe that your policy for Seven thousand three hundred and sixty five dollars, (\$7365.00) Number 13689. is issued to me and my wife only. This policy was a new issue for some reason I do not recall of one given on my and my wifes application to Mr. Edward Stabler, President, in January 1878. That application shows that under the will of the late Francis P. Blair, my son Blair Lee has an interest in the property insured. His name I think should be included in policy number 13689 and any other proper corrections for his protection should also be made. It may be that as the policy refers to the application for "more particular description" as "forming a part of the policy" this is sufficient evidence of who are insured thereby, or, with the rate of insurance, be conclusive as to the absolute interest insured; yet on the whole I would prefer to avoid the possibility of question by having his name inserted in the policy.
