If a stove or stoves be used, pipes passing through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or otherwise sufficiently secured; and if pipes pass into flue on upper story it shall be with a collar and be secured with a collar or iron laid flat. No pipes shall pass through the side wall or roof. Ashes shall not be kept nearer than 25 yards to the insured buildings, unless in brick or stone ash house.
