No ashes shall be kept in wooden vessels in or about the building insured. All fire or chimney boards shall be lined at the bottom with tin or other metal.

If a stove or stoves be used, pipes passing through floor or partition, shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or otherwise sufficiently secured; and if pipes pass into flue on upper story, it shall be with an elbow, and flue shall be built with brick, laid flat. No pipe shall pass through side wall or roof.

Property in fee simple and unincumbered - Title in Robt A Miller of Albion N.C., and occupied by Warwick P Miller

A two story wooden dwelling 30 x 20 ft with a back building 1 1/2 stories 23 x 17 ft adjoining - The dwelling contains two rooms, and a passage on the lower floor, three chambers, and a passage on the second, and two chambers, on the third floor (including front back building) and all lathing + plastering - Kitchen adjoining the back building 23 x 12 feet - One chimney and one flue - <sup>two</sup> fire places - 3 stoves used, the pipes secured according to printed instructions - Ashes to be kept not less than 25 yards from the buildings insured, unless in a brick or stone ash-pit

A wooden stable 25 x 25 ft about 50 yards N.E. of dwelling

Household and Kitchen Furniture Consisting of Table, Chairs, Beds, Bedding, Sofas, Carpets, Looking Glasses, Stoves, Cooking utensils, &c
