No unbleached ashes shall be kept in wooden vessels nearer than 30 feet to the insured buildings, unless in brick or stone ash house. All fire or chimney boards shall be lined at the bottom with tin or other metal.

The stove or stove pipe used, passing through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or otherwise sufficiently secured; and if pipes pass into flue on upper story it shall be with an elbow and the flue shall be pulled down into flue of lower story and secured with a cap, they must be securely arranged and the pipe not less than six inches in diameter in the clear. No pipe shall pass through the side wall or roof.
