If a stove or stoves be used, pipes passing through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metallic cylinder, or otherwise suitably secured; and if pipes pass into the upper story it shall be with an iron collar to be built with iron or laid flat. No pipes shall pass through the sidewall or roof. Ashes shall not be kept nearer than 25 yards to the insured buildings, unless in brick or stone ash house.
