If a stove or stoves be used, pipes leading through floor or partition shall be secured with an earthen collar or metal cylinder, or otherwise sufficiently secured; and if pipes pass into flue on upper story it shall be with an elbow, and the flue shall be built with brick, laid flat; or, when fire or chimneys are used, they must be securely arranged so that the pipe not less than six inches in diameter is the clear. No pipe shall pass through the side wall or roof.
